THE CALL TO WORSHIP (an invitation to meet with God)

Call led by Pastor

We are here today to worship our awesome Creator, stand and read the Scripture on the screens with me:

"Shout with joy to God, all the earth! Sing the glory of his name; make his praise glorious! Say to God, 'How awesome are your deeds! So great is your power that your enemies cringe before you. All the earth bows down to you; they sing praise to you, they sing praise to your name."

As we take time to confess our sins, let us lay them aside so that they will not hinder us from worshipping Him, living for Him and serving Him. Take a few moments to talk to the Lord about your sin, laying it aside.

GOSPEL (hearing and receiving the Good News of God's grace to us in Christ)

Gospel led by Pastor

Hebrews 12:2 goes on to say: "Looking to Jesus the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God."
